Did you know?

Did you know?

20% of asset information is incorrect or non-existent in asset registries (i.e. make, model, year, registration number. **Fun fact:** there are 5 different spellings for “Caterpillar” across Fleetyr customers.

Our customers’ average asset age is **5.25 years old**. Cost, transition to EVs, and access to new assets are all considerations Fleet Managers now have to deal with when looking at asset rotation.

Novated lease vehicles contribute only **26%** of total distance travelled in work hours.
